The Supreme Court (Court of Appeal) Rules, made by the Chief Justice and two other judges of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court selected by him under section 17(2)(b) of the Supreme Court Order Cap. 422A.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Supreme Court (Court of Appeal) (Amendment) Rules, 1996. Short title

Part I

Fees of Court in Civil Appeals from the High Court.

1. On filing notice of appeal against a final judgment or decision, entering the appeal for hearing and on judgment thereunder an inclusive fee of \$200.00

2. On filing respondents notice of intention to contend that decision of court below be varied \$150.00

3. For entering a special case, case stated, point of law or demurrer for argument, entering same for hearing and on judgment thereunder an inclusive fee of \$175.00

4. On filing notice of appeal against an interlocutory order or decision, entering the

appeal for hearing and on judgment there- under an inclusive fee of	\$175.00
5. On making any application not otherwise specifically provided for, and for filing judgment or order thereunder an inclusive fee of	\$100.00
6. On filing bond to secure costs of appeal	\$75.00
7. On filing motion for leave to appeal to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council	\$250.00
8. On filing every bond where the appeal is to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council	\$250.00
9. On filing order for leave to appeal to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council	\$300.00
10. On appointment to settle record on appeal to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council	\$250.00
11. On sealing record on appeal to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council	\$20.00
12. On filing every document or exhibit for which no special fee is provided	\$10.00
13. On taxation of bill of costs including certificate	\$25.00

| 20. On sealing a writ of subpoena not exceeding three persons | \$25.00 |
| 21. For a certificate of the Registrar for which no special fee is provided | \$25.00 |
| 22. On obtaining appointment for examination of a witness before an officer of the Court or other person | \$25.00 |

23. In respect of every witness examined by an officer or other person in his office, for each hour or part of an hour \$25.00
24. For an examination of witnesses away from the office of the examiner, the reasonable travelling and other expenses in addition to the fee chargeable under item 23 to be determined by Registrar
25. For making every search \$15.00
26. For an office copy of any document filed in the Registry per folio of 100 words, for the first folio \$15.00

of 100 words
27. On office copies of any document to be included in the record— including judges' notes of evidence, for the first folio to consist of 100 words \$1.00
per folio

28. On certifying any document as an office copy \$25.00
