In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Supreme Court Order Cap 422A, Revised Laws of Antigua & Barbuda, 1992, as amended, and with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers and the Premiers of all the States, the Judicial and Legal Services Commission makes this Order:

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Judges Salaries) (Amendment) Order 2012, and shall be read as one with the Supreme Court Order Cap 422A, Revised Laws of Antigua & Barbuda, 1992 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Order”).

2. Commencement

This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2007.

3. Substitution of Schedule 3

Schedule 3 of the principal Order is amended by repealing Schedule 3 and substituting the following—

“SCHEDULE 3 **[Section 11]**

SALARIES OF JUDGES OF SUPREME COURT

Chief Justice	EC\$235,800 per year
Justice of Appeal	EC\$196,560 per year
High Court Judge	EC\$163,800 per year”
