

ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1995, No. 9

Saint John's Development Corporation (Heritage Quay) (Amendment) Regulations 1995, made by the Minister under section 26 of the Saint John's Development Corporation Act, 1986 (No. 1 of 1986).

1. These Regulations may be cited as Saint John's Development Corporation (Heritage Quay) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995. Short title.

2. The Saint John's Development Corporation (Heritage Quay) Regulations, 1993 (No. 53 of 1993) referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations are amended in regulation 7 as follows — Amendment of Regulation 7.

- (a) by renumbering subregulations (2), (3), (4) and (5) as subregulations (3), (4), (5) and (6);
- (b) by inserting the following as subregulation (2)

“(2) For the purposes of this regulation the car parks and parking lots are:

- (a) Lower High Street, starting from the junction of Thames Street and High Street to the west and ending at the waterfront;
- (b) Lower St. Mary's Street, starting from the junction of Market Street and St. Mary's Street to the west and ending at Heritage Quay;
- (c) Lower Redcliffe Street, starting from the junction of Thames Street and Redcliffe Street, to the west and ending at the waterfront”.

3. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulation is amended as follows — Amendment of regulation 8.

- (a) by deleting the word "Managing" in subregulation (4) and substituting the word "Executive";
- (b) by renumbering subregulation (4) thereof as subregulation (5); and
- (c) by inserting the following as subregulation (4).

"(4) Neither the Executive Director nor a police officer authorized by the Executive Director, nor a person directed by a police officer, to remove or immobilize a vehicle not permitted to enter —

- (a) a Scheduled place; or
- (b) park in a place, other than, the place allotted for the parking of such vehicle,

shall be liable for any damage to, or loss of any part of or article in the vehicle so removed or immobilized".

Amendment of regulation 11.

4. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulation is amended by —

- (a) revoking sub-regulation (3); and
- (b) inserting after regulation 11 the following new regulation —

"Penalty

12. Every person who contravenes any of these regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five thousand dollars or to imprisonment for two years."

Amendment of Schedule I.

5. Schedule I to the principal Regulations is amended by adding the following —

- (c) Lower High Street, west of the junction of Thames Street and High Street to the waterfront;
- (d) Lower Saint Mary's Street, west of the junction of Market Street and Saint Mary's Street to the Heritage Quay;

(e) Lower Redcliffe Street, west of the junction of Thames Street and Redcliffe Street to the waterfront”.

6. Schedules II and III to the principal regulations are revoked and replaced by the following —

Revocation and replacement of Schedules II and III.

1. Traders allocated with Kiosks — four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month, payable in advance.
2. Public Service Vehicles allocated with parking lots three hundred and sixty-five dollars (\$365.00) per annum, payable annually in advance.
3. Sanitary Vehicles entering the Heritage Quay for the Collection and removal of waste from cruise ships and other vessels — one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per entry, payable by the agent.
