STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Sierra Club Centennial Order, 1994 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Sierra Club Centennial Order, 1994.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps in two sheetlets, comprising eight stamps in the denomination of \$1.50 and four Souvenir Sheets costing \$1.50 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are multicoloured and of horizontal format.

- (a) Sheetlet I features two Bactrian Camels, two African Elephants, three Leopards and the Sierra Club Logo;
- (b) Sheetlet II features two Sumatran Rhinoceros, two Ring-tailed Lemurs, three Red-fronted Brown Lemurs and Sierra Club Logo;
- (c) Souvenir Sheet I features a Sumatran Rhinoceros;
- (d) Souvenir Sheet II features an African Elephant;
- (e) Souvenir Sheet III features a Bactrian Camel;
- (f) Souvenir Sheet IV features a Ring-tailed Lemur.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 31st May, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 1st March, 1994.
