The Social Security Modification of Insurance Status and Voluntary Insurance (Amendment of Third Schedule) Regulations made by the Minister under sections 19(3), 23, 20 and 47 of the Social Security Act, Cap. 408.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security Modification of Insurance Status and Voluntary Insurance (Amendment of Third Schedule) Regulations, 2003. Short title.

2. The Third Schedule to the Social Security Modification of Insurance Status and Voluntary Insurance Regulations (SRO 13 of 1974) is amended by the revocation of paragraph 6 and the substitution of the following — Amendment of third schedule.

“Employment of any person by any International Organization recognised by the Government of Antigua and Barbuda, being a person to whom any scheme of Social Security benefits operated by such organization applies; and for the purpose of this paragraph the term “International Organization” includes a Regional Organization, other than the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS).”

3. Any person who, on or after the 1st day of July 1993 is an employee of the Divisions of the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS) located in Antigua and Barbuda shall, on such terms and conditions as the Board may, by resolution approve, be deemed to be an insured person on the date of commencement of such employment and be liable for the payment of contributions from that date but not earlier than the 1st of July 1993. Crediting contributions.
