Social Security (Benefits) (Invalidity Pensions and Grants) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000 made by the Minister under sections 29, 30 and 31 of the Social Security Act, Cap. 408.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Benefits) (Invalidity Pensions and Grants) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000. Short title.

2. Regulation 2 of the Social Security (Benefits) (Invalidity Pensions and Grants) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, is amended by repealing in the definition of "invalid" the following:

", otherwise than as a result of employment injury";

Amendment of regulation 2 of the Social Security (Benefits) (Invalidity Pensions and Grants) Regulations, Cap. 408(k).

3. After regulation 6 of the principal Regulations, the following regulation is inserted: Insertion of new regulation.

"Increase of Pension. 6A. All existing pensions under these regulations awarded before the 1st day of January, 2000 are increased by ten per centum."

4. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (a) by repealing "one thousand" and substituting the following: Amendment of regulation 8.

"one thousand two hundred".

5. These Regulations come into force on the 1st day of January, 2000. Commencement.
