**Social Security (Benefits) (Age Pensions and Grants)  
(Amendment) Regulations, made by the Minister under  
section 29, 30 and 31 of the Social Security Act, Cap. 408.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Benefits) (Age Pensions and Grants) (Amendment) Regulations, 2005. Short title.
  
2. Regulation 8 of the Social Security (Benefits) (Age Pensions and Grants) Regulations, in these regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, is amended by the deletion of the words “minimum rate of one hundred and thirty-six dollars and fifty cents per month and a maximum of two hundred and twenty-seven dollars and fifty cents per month” and the substitution of the words “subject to a minimum rate of three hundred and fifty dollars per month.” Amendment of  
Regulation 8.
  
3. Regulation 8A of the principal regulations is amended in subsection (2), by deleting the words “one hundred and thirty-six dollars and fifty cents per month or more than two hundred and twenty seven dollars and fifty cents per month” and substituting the words “three hundred and fifty dollars per month.” Amendment of  
Regulation 8A.
  
4. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is revoked and regulation 8A, as amended, is renumbered as regulation 9. Revocation of  
regulation 9 and  
renumbering of  
regulation 8A.
  
5. These regulations come into force on the 1st day of February, 2005. Commencement
