The Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) Order, 1995 made by the Governor-General under section 11 of the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) Act, 1983 (No. 8 of 1983).

1. These Orders may be cited as the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) Order, 1995. Short title.

2. The Schedule to the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) Act, 1983 (No. 8 of 1983) is revoked and replaced by the following — Schedule repealed and replaced.
