WORK PERMIT EXEMPTION ORDER, 2003

WHEREAS by Section F3 (g) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code it is enacted that the provisions of Division F (Work Permits Division) of the said Labour Code shall not apply to any employed person who is a person or one of a class of persons to whom, by Order of the Minister, this Division shall be declared not to apply:

AND WHEREAS the government of Antigua and Barbuda has reviewed its employment policy and made recommendations relating to Non-nationals who have resided lawfully in the State of Antigua and Barbuda for a continuous period of three years and who have applied for and granted Temporary Residence Status:

AND WHEREAS the Minister has given due consideration to the said recommendations:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered as follows —

1. This order is cited as the Work Permit Exemption Order, Citation.
2003.

2. Non-nationals who have been granted Temporary Residence Status are exempted from having a work permit with effect from 1st June 2003. Exemption Order.
