Interpretation

- 1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

"passage" means passage by sea or air between the United Kingdom and Bermuda for His Excellency the Governor, the dependent members of his family and his person staff—

- (a) on taking up his appointment in Bermuda;
- (b) on returning to the United Kingdom at the conclusion of his initial term of office;
- (c) where there is an extension of his term of office, returning to Bermuda to resume his office;
- (d) on returning to the United Kingdom at the conclusion of an extended term of office;

"United Kingdom passage grant" means the grant of money paid to His Excellency the Governor in virtue of his office as Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Bermuda by Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom in respect of his expenses incurred by him on passages.

GOVERNOR'S PASSAGES ALLOWANCE ACT 1963

Grant of allowance for passages

2 There shall be paid to His Excellency the Governor out of the Consolidated Fund an allowance towards the cost of the expenditure incurred by him on passages in respect of which he receives or is entitled to a United Kingdom passage grant, a sum equal to the excess (if any) of the total expenditure incurred by him on such passages since his term of office commenced over the total United Kingdom passage grants paid or payable to him in respect thereof:

Provided that the total amount paid to His Excellency the Governor under this Act during his term of office shall not exceed the aggregate amount paid to him by way of United Kingdom passage grants in respect of that period.
