**AUXILIARY BICYCLES (EMISSIONS STANDARDS) ORDER
2004**

The Minister of Tourism and Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 17A(2)(a) of the Auxiliary Bicycles Act 1954, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Auxiliary Bicycles (Emissions Standards) Order 2004.

Approval of emissions standards

2 The following emissions standards are hereby approved, that is to say, the emissions standards in respect of auxiliary bicycles set from time to time—

- (a) by the Automobile Standards Internationalization Center of Japan and contained in articles 31, 31-2 and 58 of the Ministry of Transport Ordinance No. 67 of 1951 as may be from time to time amended;
- (b) by the Environmental Protection Agency of the United States and contained in—
 - (i) the Clean Air Act 42 U.S.C. 7041 et. Seq.; and
 - (ii) title 40 and Parts 86 and 88 to 90 of the Code of Federal Regulations,

as may be from time to time amended; and

- (c) by the European Council and contained in European Council Directive 97/24/EC of 17 June 1997, Official Journal of the European Communities L226/1 of 18 August 1997, as may be from time to time amended.
