Form of application

1 The form of application for a certificate of entitlement under section 38 of the Health Insurance Act 1970 shall be in accordance with the form set out in the Schedule or as near thereto as circumstances admit.

Form of certificate

2 Where the Committee is satisfied that a person in respect of whom an application is made is entitled to subsidized hospital treatment he shall issue to the applicant a certificate of entitlement in the following form—
