BERMUDA LIBRARY REDESIGNATION ACT 1996

[Date of Assent 3 June 1996]

[Operative Date

WHEREAS it is expedient to redesignate the Bermuda Library as the national library of Bermuda:

Be it enacted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Assembly of Bermuda, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

 $1\,$ $\,$ This Act may be cited as the Bermuda Library Redesignation Act 1996.

Redesignation of the Bermuda Library

- 2 (1) With effect from the date of commencement of this Act, the Bermuda Library is established as the national library of Bermuda and is accordingly redesignated as the Bermuda National Library for all purposes.
- (2) The expression "the Bermuda Library" in subsection (1) has the meaning that was assigned to it by section 1 of the Bermuda Library Act 1946 ("the 1946 Act") immediately before the above date.

BERMUDA LIBRARY REDESIGNATION ACT 1996

Consequential amendment of certain enactments

- Consequentially upon section 2-
 - (a) the 1946 Act is re-titled "the Bermuda National Library Act 1946";
 - (b) subject to the first item in the Schedule to this Act, wherever in the 1946 Act or in any regulations under that Act the phrase "Bermuda Library" appears, the phrase "Bermuda National Library" is substituted;
 - (c) the enactments specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Act are amended in the manner respectively specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

Commencement

This Act comes into operation on such day as the Minister responsible for Archives may appoint by notice published in the Gazette.

Delete "Library as established under the Bermuda Library Act 1946" and substitute "National

Library"

The First Schedule to the Copyright (Libraries) Regulations 1964:

Insert "National" immediately

before "Library"

Paragraph 2(a) of the Hamilton (Corporation Lands) Ordinance

Insert "National" immediately before "Library"
