CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT AMENDMENT ACT 2010

2010 : 14

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Customs Department Act 1952;

Be it enacted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Assembly of Bermuda, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Citation

1 This Act may be cited as the Customs Department Amendment Act 2010.

Amends section 4A

2 In section 4A(2) of the Customs Department Act 1952 ("the principal Act") delete "in accompanied passenger's baggage for" and substitute "by or on behalf of".

Inserts section 4B

3 After section 4A of the principal Act insert the following section—

"Charges for customs stamps, seals etc.

4B The fee prescribed under the Government Fees Regulations 1976 shall be paid to the Collector of Customs in respect of the use or application of customs stamps, seals, certificates and other forms of certification or identification provided by the Department."

Consequential amendment

4 In Head 15 of the Schedule to the Government Fees Regulations 1976 add the following paragraph—

CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT AMENDMENT ACT 2010

“(6) Certifying under section 4B that goods have been landed
in Bermuda
