MOTOR CAR AMENDMENT ACT 1995

[Date of Assent 29 March 1995]

[Operative Date 29 March 1995]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Motor Car Act 1951:

Be it enacted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Assembly of Bermuda, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Citation

1 This Act which amends the Motor Car Act 1951 may be cited as the Motor Car Amendment Act 1995.

Amends section 54 of Motor Car Act 1951

- 2 Section 54 of the Motor Car Act 1951 is amended in subsection (9)—
 - (a) by deleting the word "and" at the end of the definition of the expression "dealer" and by deleting the full stop at the end of the definition of the expression "modified motor car" and substituting therefore the words ";and"; and
 - (b) by inserting next after the definition of the expression "modified motor car" the following—

""motor car" includes a motor cycle.".
