EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19 CONTINUING PRECAUTIONS) AMENDMENT (NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2020

BR 62 / 2020

His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the power conferred by section 3 of the Emergency Powers Act 1963, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations which amend the Emergency Powers (COVID-19 Continuing Precautions) Regulations 2020 ("the principal Regulations"), may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19 Continuing Precautions) Amendment (No. 4) Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 4

- 2 In regulation 4 of the principal Regulations, at the end insert—
 - "(5) The Minister of National Security may, if he considers that there are exceptional circumstances justifying an exemption from this regulation, grant an exemption (a "large group exemption") permitting a group of more than ten persons to assemble—
 - (a) on a specified date; and
 - (b) at a specified time and place,

provided appropriate physical distancing is maintained at all times, and subject to such conditions as the Minister may impose.

(6) Notice of a large group exemption and any conditions imposed by the Minister shall be published in the Gazette at least one day before the specified date."

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19 CONTINUING PRECAUTIONS) AMENDMENT (NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2020

Amends regulation 16

- 3 In regulation 16 of the principal Regulations—
 - (a) delete paragraph (2) and substitute—
 - "(2) No person shall use a boat for recreational purposes—
 - (a) after 7pm; or
 - (b) after 9pm, in a case where the boat is operated commercially for hire or reward in accordance with paragraph (4).";
 - (b) in paragraph (4), after "operated" insert "commercially".
