#### THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (BCH CODE) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1996

#### Modifications of SI 1987 No. 550

2 (1) The Merchant Shipping (BCH Code) Regulations 1987<sup>\*\*</sup>, as amended, for the time being in force under article 3(1) of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Order 1987 as it applies in the United Kingdom shall, subject to the further modifications specified in paragraph (2), be deemed to be amended by the Governor under article 3 of the Merchant Shipping (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Order 1987, as extended to Bermuda.
