HENRYK PODLEWSKI (PRIVATE PRACTICE)

An Act to enable Henryk Podlewski to Engage in Consulting and Private Practice as a Psychiatrist.

[Commencement 15th July, 1957]

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Henryk Podlewski Short title. (Private Practice) Act.
 - 2. In this Act —

Interpretation.

"Psychiatrist" means a specialist in that branch of medicine which deals with mental disorders.

3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Medical Department Act, or any other Act, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to issue a certificate authorizing Henryk Podlewski to engage in consulting and private practice as a Psychiatrist subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in the certificate.

Issue of certificate.

(2) Such certificate issued under the authority of sub section (1) of this section may at any time be revoked, amended or altered by the Governor in Council.
