ANIMAL CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (PROHIBITION OF MEAT IMPORTS) ORDER

(SECTION 13)

[Commencement 16th April, 1984]

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Contagious Diseases (Prohibition of Meat Imports) Order.

2. No person shall import into the Bahamas either directly or indirectly any meat or any by-product of meat, from any place other than —

Prohibition of importation of meat.

3. (1) The provisions of paragraph 2 shall not apply to meat or any by-product of meat which has been cooked or canned except meat or by-products of meat produced in Bermuda, Finland, Greenland, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden, and the Territory of St. Pierre and Maquellan.

(2) Subparagraph (1) and paragraph 4 shall not apply to the following beef and beef products imported into The Bahamas from Canada —

S.I. 125/2010.

- (i) boneless bovine meat from cattle under 30 months of age;
- (ii) boneless sheep or goat meat from animals under 12 months of age;
- (iii) boneless veal (meat from cattle that are 30 weeks of age or younger at slaughter);
- (iv) bovine liver; and
- (v) feed ingredients that contain protein free tallow.
