

cise its regulatory functions and 60 days in all other events;

- (b) on receipt of a written application from an exempt person for an extension of the relevant time under paragraph (a), the Central Bank may grant an extension, or series of extensions, to the relevant time where he is satisfied that such an extension, or extensions, are warranted; *23 of 2010, s. 16.*
- (c) in considering an application under paragraph (b) the Central Bank may request any information that he considers relevant; *23 of 2010, s. 16.*
- (d) any extension or series of extensions granted may be subject to such conditions as are in the opinion of the Central Bank deemed necessary. *23 of 2010, s. 16.*

9. These regulations shall not apply to Money Transmission Service Providers or Money Transmission Agents. *Non-application.*

CHAPTER 316

BANKS AND TRUST COMPANIES REGULATION

BANKS (PUBLISHING AND CERTIFYING OF ANNUAL ACCOUNTS) ORDER *G.N. 133/1959*

(SECTION 8)

[Commencement 25th July, 1959]

1. This Order may be cited as the Banks (Publishing and Certifying of Annual Accounts) Order. *Citation.*

2. The correctness of annual accounts published by a bank under the provisions of section 8 of the Banks Act shall be certified by a chartered accountant or certified public accountant. *Annual accounts to be certified.*
