**EXPORT CONTROL ACT  
(CHAPTER 299)**

**EXPORT CONTROL (PROHIBITION OF SCRAP METAL AND  
COPPER) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2011**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Export Control Regulations Act, makes the following Regulations –

**1. Citation and commencement.**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Export Control (Prohibition of Scrap and Metal and Copper) (No. 2) Regulations, 2011.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2011.

**2. Temporary prohibition of export of scrap metal.**

No person shall for a period of fourteen days from the coming into force of these regulations export any scrap metal from The Bahamas to any place outside The Bahamas.

**3. Prohibition of export copper.**

No person shall export any copper from The Bahamas to any place outside The Bahamas.
