**MERCHANT SHIPPING (SMOOTH AND
 PARTIALLY SMOOTH WATERS) REGULATIONS**

S.I. 16/1981

(SECTIONS 176 and 289)

[Commencement 5th March, 1981]

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Smooth and Partially Smooth Waters) Regulations.
2. The Rules specified in column 1 of the Schedule are amended to the extent specified in columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule.
