MERCHANT SHIPPING (OIL POLLUTION) (INDEMNIFICATION OF SHIP-OWNERS) REGULATIONS

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Indemnification of Ship-owners) Regulations.

Prescribed requirements.

- 2. The requirements prescribed for the purpose of section 41(4)(a) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act, being such requirements which appear to the Minister appropriate to implement the provisions of Article 5(3) of the Fund Convention, are
 - (a) sections 4, 5, 7, 49 and 54 of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act; and
 - (b) sections 9, 173, 181, 188, 193, 194, 195, 198, 199 and 202 of the Merchant Shipping Act.

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act (Dollar Equivalent) Order.
