[Commencement 30th July, 2010]

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Insurance (Chronic Diseases Prescription Drug Fund) (Prescribed Class of Persons) Regulations.

Citation.

2. Pursuant to section 5(1)(k) of the National Insurance (Chronic Diseases Prescription Drug Fund) Act, benefits shall be provided under the Plan to the class of persons specified in the *Schedule*.

Additional class of persons to benefit under the Plan.

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SCHEDULE

(Regulation 2)

- (a) Persons who are citizens of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas who are over the age of sixty-five years and who do not fall within any of the other categories specified to section 5 of the National Insurance (Chronic Diseases Prescription Drug Fund) Act and who are not eligible to receive a pension under the National Insurance (Benefit and Assistance) Regulations;
- (b) Persons who are staff of Her Majesty's Prison and the Industrial Schools;
- (c) Persons who are members of The Royal Bahamas Police Force;
- (d) Persons who are members of The Royal Bahamas Defence Force;
- (e) Persons who are officers employed in the Public Service;
- (f) Persons sixty years of age and over in receipt of survivors benefit under regulations 24-26 and survivor's assistance under regulation 92 of the National Insurance (Benefit and Assistance) Regulations;
- (g) Persons receiving ante-natal care, care connected with child birth, post-natal care or any other medical care associated with pregnancy;

- (h) Persons in receipt of disablement benefit assessed at one hundred *per centum* under the National Insurance (Benefit and Assistance) Regulations.
