PHARMACY

PHARMACY (PROHIBITED DRUGS) RULES

*S.I. 48/1966
5 of 1987*

(SECTION 6)

[Commencement 30th June, 1966]

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pharmacy (Prohibited Drugs) Rules.

2. The manufacture, importation into the Bahamas, or sale by wholesale or retail of any drug or poison specified in the Schedule to these Rules is hereby prohibited.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of these Rules shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, and the court may order that any drug or poison concerned in the commission of the offence shall be forfeited and disposed of as the court may direct.
