# PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT (CHAPTER 36)

# PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (EMANCIPATION DAY, 2018) (OPENING OF SHOPS) NOTICE, 2018

**WHEREAS** by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act ("the Act") it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

**AND WHEREAS** the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in August is appointed a public holiday under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Monday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2018, the day celebrated as Emancipation Day in 2018:

**NOW THEREFORE** in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice—

#### 1. Citation.

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Emancipation Day, 2018) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2018.

### 2. Opening of shops on Emancipation Day, 2018.

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Monday, the  $6^{th}$  day of August, 2018, the day celebrated as Emancipation Day in 2018.
