PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT

(CHAPTER 36)

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (MAJORITY RULE DAY, 2019)(OPENING OF SHOPS)NOTICE, 2019

WHEREAS by section 6 of the Public Holidays Act (“the Act”) it is provided that the Governor-General may, in any special case in which it is expedient to do so, by notice in the *Gazette* authorize the carrying on of business in any shop on any public holiday;

AND WHEREAS the 10th day of January is appointed a public holiday under the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Governor-General considers it expedient to authorize the carrying on of business in all shops on Thursday, the 10th day of January, 2019, the day celebrated as Majority Rule Day in 2019:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Act, the Governor-General gives the following Notice —

1. Citation.

This Notice may be cited as the Public Holidays (Majority Rule Day, 2019) (Opening of Shops) Notice, 2019.

2. Opening of shops on Majority Rule Day, 2019.

Business may be carried on in all shops during normal business hours on Thursday, the 10th day of January, 2019, the day celebrated as Majority Rule Day in 2019.
