[Commencement 15th August, 1997]

- Citation. **1.** This Order may be cited as the Plants Protection (Restriction on Imports of Fruits, Vegetables, Flowers, Plants and other Propagative Materials) (Pink Mealybug) Order.
- Interpretation. **2.** In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —
- Schedule. “declared country” means a country referred to in the Schedule.
- Prohibition on imports. **3.** No person shall import into The Bahamas, either directly or indirectly, from any declared country, any Fruits, Vegetables, Flowers, Plants or other Propagative Materials.

CANKER) ORDER**

(SECTION 5)

[Commencement 28th January, 2005]

- Citation. **1.** This Order may be cited as the Plants Protection (Restriction on the Movement of Seeds, Fruits, Plants and other Propagative Materials) (Citrus Canker) Order.
- Infected island. **2.** The island of Abaco in The Bahamas is hereby declared to be a place infected with the citrus canker disease.
- Restriction on movement of propagative materials. **3.** No person shall remove from the island of Abaco in The Bahamas any seed, fruit, plant or other propagative material of a citrus plant.
