**PLANT PROTECTION ACT, 2016**  
**(No. 6 of 2016)**

**PLANT PROTECTION (FEES) REGULATIONS, 2023**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 55(1)(f) of the Plant Protection Act, 2016 (*No. 6 of 2016*) hereby makes the following regulations —

**1. Citation and commencement.**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Protection (Fees) Regulations, 2023
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2023.

**2. Application fees.**

There shall be payable in respect of an application for —

- (a) the registration of a plant establishment under section 25 of the Act;
- (b) an import permit under section 32 of the Act;
- (c) a phytosanitary certificate under section 40 of the Act,

the applicable fees shown in the *Schedule*.
