

## CHAPTER 361

### PUBLIC TREASURY BILLS

#### **PUBLIC TREASURY BILLS (RATE OF DISCOUNT) ORDER**

S.I.39/1975

(SECTION 3(2))

*[Commencement 15th May, 1975]*

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Treasury Bills (Rate of Discount) Order.

Citation

2. For the purposes of this Order “the Act” means the Public Treasury Bills Act.

3. Treasury bills issued under the provisions of the Act may be issued at a rate of discount not exceeding ten per centum.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Treasury Bills Regulations.

Title

2. Treasury bills shall be in the form in Schedule I of these Regulations and shall bear the facsimile signature of the Treasurer. They shall be printed on security paper with protective inking and protective water mark of a size five inches by seven inches. The bills shall be numbered as prescribed by the Treasurer and shall be issued in the following denominations —

\$ 400  
\$ 2,000  
\$ 4,000  
\$ 20,000
