**ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR CYCLES)
(PROTECTIVE HELMETS) REGULATIONS**

(SECTION 98)

[Commencement 1st July, 1975]

- Citation. **1.** The Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motor Cycles) (Protective Helmets) Regulations.
- Protective helmets. **2.** Every person driving and riding on a motor cycle shall wear at all times a protective helmet of the shape, construction or other qualities set out in regulation 3 of these Regulations.
- Standard of helmets. **3.** Protective helmets referred to in regulation 2 of these Regulations shall conform to the standards set by the International Organization for Standardization.
- Offences. **4.** Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine of one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of two hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months.

APPLICATION OF ACT
