

**TUGS AND LIGHTERS (LICENCE AND CERTIFICATE) ORDER**

G.N. 42/1962

(SECTION 25)

*[Commencement 10th March, 1962]*

1. This Order may be cited as the Tugs and Lighters (Licence and Certificate) Order.

2. Tugs or lighters operated within The Bahamas shall be licensed and a certificate issued to the owner or to the person in charge thereof in the form prescribed in the Schedule hereto.

**PORT AUTHORITIES (PRESCRIPTION OF LICENSED PILOTS) ORDER, 2002**

S.I. 42/2002

(SECTION 41)

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Port Authorities (Prescription of Licensed Pilots) Order, 2002.

Appointment of licensed pilots.

2. (1) Eight licensed pilots are hereby prescribed for the Port of Nassau.

(2) Two licensed pilots are hereby prescribed for the port areas in the Family Islands.
