

TOWN PLANNING (GREEN CAY) ZONING ORDER, 1998 *S.I. 45/1998*

(SECTION 5)

[Commencement 21st July, 1998]

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Town Planning (Green Cay) Zoning Order, 1998. Citation.
- 2. In this Order — Interpretation.
 - “building” includes —
 - (a) any part of a building and, any addition to any building of whatsoever material and in whatsoever manner constructed, any installation, machinery and plant fixed or attached to any building or property;
 - (b) any wall, fence or similar structure bounded by or fronting on a public highway;
 - (c) any other boundary wall, fence or similar structure.
- 3. No person shall build any buildings upon the area of land described in the Schedule hereto. Building prohibited.

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 3)

ALL THAT certain Island, Cay or Islet known as GREEN CAY containing by admeasurement FIVE HUNDRED AND TWENTY ACRES or thereabouts recorded in Grant Book K Page 136 at the Department of Lands and Surveys situated on the eastern edge of the Tongue of the Ocean sixty-five (65) miles Southwardly of the Island of New Providence and twenty-two (22) miles Eastwardly of the Island of South Andros in the Commonwealth of The Bahamas ABUTTING AND BOUNDING on all sides by the Sea which said Island, Cay or Islet is more particularly delineated and shown coloured pink on the extract of the map of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas series H 000 attached hereto and marked Annex (A).
