TRADE UNION REGULATIONS

S.I. 20/1971

(SECTION 11)

[Commencement 1st March, 1971]

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| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trade Union Regulations. | Citation. |
| 2. In these Regulations —
“Act” means the Industrial Relations Act;
“Registrar” means the officer designated by the Minister pursuant to section 5 of the Act. | Interpretation. |
| 3. Application for the registration of a trade union shall be made in Form A in the Schedule. | Application for registration. Schedule. |
| 4. The certificate of registration of a trade union shall be in Form B in the Schedule. | Certificate of registration. Schedule. |
| 5. The following shall be the fees payable under the Act — | Fees. |
| (a) for registration of a trade union — section 12 | \$25.00 |
| (b) for registration of a resolution for amendment of the constitution of a trade union — section 17(3) | \$15.00 |
| (c) for registration of a resolution for a change of name only of a trade union — section 18 | \$15.00 |
| (d) for a direction to transfer stock, money or securities — section 25 | \$10.00 |
| (e) for every copy of a document, or of any extract from a document, in the custody of the Registrar, for every page or part of a page — section 5(2) | \$1.00 |
| (f) for every inspection of any document or documents in the custody of the Registrar relating to one trade union, for every hour or part of an hour — section 5(2) | 50c |

but so that no fee shall be payable under paragraph (e) or (f) of this regulation by any public officer in the exercise by him of any public duty, or by any Government department, or by any body established directly by statute and exercising powers vested in such body by law for a public purpose.

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Relations (Increase of Tribunal Members) Order. Citation.

INDUSTRIAL TRIBUNAL (SALARIES FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT) ORDER

S.I 78/2009.

(SECTION 54(8))

[Commencement 1st July, 2009]

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Tribunal (Salaries for President and Vice President) Order. Citation.

2. There shall be paid — Salaries and allowances of members.

(a) to the person holding the Tribunal Office of President —

(i) a salary of seventy thousand dollars per annum;

(ii) a responsibility allowance of six thousand dollars per annum; and

(iii) a scarcity allowance of fifteen thousand dollars per annum;

(b) to the respective persons holding the Tribunal Office of Vice President —
