CITY OF NASSAU REVITALIZATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2013

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CITY OF NASSAU REVITALIZATION ACT

[Date of Assent - 1st July, 2013]

Enacted by the Parliament of The Bahamas

1. Short title and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the City of Nassau Revitalization (Amendment) Act, 2013.
- (2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2013.

2. Amendment of section 1 of Ch. 328B.

Section 1 of the City of Nassau Revitalization Act is amended by the insertion immediately after subsection (2) of the following —

- “(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), the Minister may by order extend the period specified in subsection (2) for such period not exceeding one year as appears necessary for the revitalization of the City of Nassau.”.

3. Amendment of section 2 of Ch. 328B.

Section 2 of the City of Nassau Revitalization Act is amended by the deletion of the definition and expression of the “City of Nassau” and the substitution therefor of the following —

“**City of Nassau**” for the purposes of this Act, means all that part of New Providence bounded on the north by the Harbour of Nassau, on the east by Montague and Shirley Street, on the south by an imaginary line starting at a point approximately three hundred and eighty yards to the south of the junction of Mackey Street and Shirley Street and continuing in a straight line to the south-east corner of

the grounds of the Princess Margaret Hospital, thence south-westerly to Prison Lane, thence to the division wall between the Barracks and the Prison, thence in a straight line westwardly to the junction of Dillet Street and Blue Hill Road and following the centre of Dillet Street and Meeting Street to Nassau Street, and on the west by Chippingham Road, and includes Botanical Gardens and the Ardastra Gardens.”.
