IMMIGRATION ACT (CHAPTER 191) IMMIGRATION (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2015

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Immigration Act, makes the following Regulations —

1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015.

The Schedule to the Immigration (Fees) Regulations is amended as follows —
