OLD FARRINGTON ROAD CLOSURE

An Act to authorize the stopping up of the Old Farrington Road in the Western District of New Providence.

[Commencement 27th May, 1966]

WHEREAS the course of Farrington Road in the Western District of the Island of New Providence in the vicinity of the sub-division known as Cunningham Acres has been diverted and certain portions of the existing public road have become disused:

and WHEREAS certain owners and occupiers of properties adjacent to the existing public road have made proposals for the purchase of the said portions:

1. This Act may be cited as the Old Farrington Road Closure Act 1966.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act, it shall be lawful —

- (a) for the Treasurer to convey in fee simple to any owner or occupier of land adjacent thereto those portions of the old Farrington Road which are delineated on a plan filed with a copy of this Act in the Department of Public Works, in consideration of such sums of money or other consideration as the Minister for Works may deem good and sufficient; and
- (b) for the Minister for Works to stop up and close those portions of the old Farrington Road conveyed by the Treasurer under the provisions of this section.

3. Upon the said portions of the public road being stopped up and closed in manner provided by paragraph (b) of section 2 of this Act, the right of the public to the use of the same shall cease and be extinguished.
