CENTRAL BANK OF THE BAHAMAS ACT (CHAPTER 351)

CURRENCY (NOTES AND COINS) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2016

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Central Bank of The Bahamas Act, after consultation with the Bank, makes the following Order —

1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the Currency (Notes and Coins) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2016.

2. Amends Second Schedule to S.I. No. 112 of 2013.

The Second Schedule to the Currency (Notes and Coins) Order, 2013 is amended by inserting, in the appropriate position, the following —
