The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Central Bank of The Bahamas Act, after consultation with the Bank, makes the following Order –

1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the Currency (Notes and Coins) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2019.

2. Amends Second Schedule to S.I. No. 112 of 2013.

The Second Schedule to the Currency (Notes and Coins) Order, 2013 is amended by inserting, in the appropriate position, the following –

				of a Bahamas Conch Shell resting on the seashore, flanked below the inscription "250 DOLLARS".
One Hundred Dollars: Numismatic Regular Issue Coin	7.80 gms	.9999 Gold	+/- 0.15 mm thickness	A round coin measuring 22.00 mm in diameter, 1.40 mm in thickness with a milled edge, bearing on the obverse the Coat of Arms of The Bahamas together with the words "Commonwealth of The Bahamas" which forms a crown around the Coat of Arms. Below the Coat of Arms is the year, 2019. The reverse features an artist's rendering of an Atlantic Blue Marlin 'splashing' out of the water, flanked on the right by the inscription "100 DOLLARS".
