**CURRENCY (NOTES AND COINS) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 4)
ORDER, 2016**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Central Bank of The Bahamas Act, after consultation with the Bank, makes the following Order —

1. Citation.

This Order, may be cited as the Currency (Notes and Coins) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 2016.

2. Amends Second Schedule to S.I. No. 112 of 2013.

The Second Schedule to the Currency (Notes and Coins) Order is amended by inserting, in the appropriate position, the following —

Below the Coat of Arms is the date, 2016. The reverse features an artist's rendering of the members of The Bahamas' gold medal winning 2012 men's 4x400m relay team featuring: Chris Brown, Demetrius Pinder, Michael Mathieu and Ramon Miller.
