**CENTRAL ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR EDUCATION
RULES***G N 253/1962
Act 25 of 1995*

(SECTION 9)

[Commencement 17th November, 1962]

- 1.** These Rules may be cited as the Central Advisory Council for Education Rules. Short title.
- 2.** The term of office of the members of the Central Advisory Council for Education appointed by the Minister under the provisions of subsection (2) of section 7 of the Education Act shall be for a period not exceeding three years. Term of office of members of Central Advisory Council.

- 3.** (1) The Minister may terminate the appointment of any member of the Advisory Council if the Minister is satisfied that a member —
- (a) has been absent from meetings of the Council for a period longer than three consecutive months without the permission of the Council; or
 - (b) is incapacitated by illness; or
 - (c) is otherwise unable or unfit to discharge the functions of a member.
- (2) Upon a member of the Council communicating in writing to the Minister a wish to resign from the Advisory Council for Education, the Minister may accept such resignation and such member shall therefrom cease to be a member of the Council. Conditions of retirement of members of the council.
- 4.** The Minister may appoint a new member to fill any vacancy occurring in the membership of the Advisory Council for Education and the member so appointed shall hold office until and inclusive of the thirty-first day of December next ensuing. Vacancies.
