## CENTRAL BANK OF THE BAHAMAS ACT, 2020 (No. 24 of 2020)

## CENTRAL BANK (FIFTY DOLLAR GOLD PROOF COIN) (1 OUNCE) (JUNKANOO) (INDEPENDENCE) ORDER, 2023

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Central Bank of The Bahamas Act, 2020, after consultation with the Bank, makes the following Order —

#### 1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the Central Bank (Fifty Dollar Gold Proof Coin) (1 Ounce) (Junkanoo) (Independence) Order, 2023.

#### 2. Denomination, forms, designs, etc.

The denomination, forms, designs, gross weight and composition of the Fifty Dollar Gold Proof Coin issued by the Bank, and the devices to be borne by such coins, shall be as specified in the Schedule.

#### Fifty Dollar Gold Proof Coin - Junkanoo (Independence)

Denomination	Gross Weight in grams	Metallic Composition	Forms, Designs and Devices
Fifty Dollars Numismatic Coin	31.21	.9999 Gold	A round coin measuring 38.61 mm in diameter with a milled edge, bearing on the obverse the Coat of Arms of The Bahamas together with the words "Commonwealth of The Bahamas" which forms a crown around the Coat of Arms. Below the Coat of Arms is the year, 2023. The reverse features an artist's rendering of male and female Junkanooers in traditional costumes, flanked above by the inscription "50th Anniversary of Independence 1973-2023" and on the left by the inscription "50 DOLLARS".
