CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT (APPOINTMENT OF CUSTOMS' SEAL AND FLAG) NOTICE

S.I. 7/1989

(SECTION 5)

[Commencement 19th January, 1985]

- 1. The Seal of the Customs, which shall be officially and judicially noticed, is appointed to be a seal consisting of the perforated impressions set out at (A) in the Schedule.
- 2. The Flag as described at (B) in the Schedule is appointed the Flag of Customs and shall be the flag which will distinguish vessels employed in the Customs from other vessels.
- 3. This Notice may be cited as the Customs Management (Appointment of Customs' Seal and Flag) Notice, 1989.
