## DANGEROUS DRUGS (PRESCRIPTION OF MINIMUM AMOUNTS) RULES, 1989

## (SECTIONS 22 and 33)

[Commencement 16th February, 1989]

1. These Rules may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Prescription of Minimum Amounts) Rules, 1989.

2. For the purposes of subsection (3) of section 22 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, the possession of any quantity of the dangerous drug named in the first column of the Schedule in excess of the quantity respectively specified against that drug in the second column of the Schedule shall raise the presumption of possession with intent to supply.

## SCHEDULE

First Column Second Column DANGEROUS DRUG MINIMUM QUANTITY Cocaine 10 grams Indian hemp 500 grams Lysergic acid diethylamide and any compound declared by the Minister by order to be related to lysergic acid diethylamide 10 milligrams Opium morphine and its salts diacetylmorphine including (commonly known as heroin) 2 grams Methaqualone 1 gram or, if the drug is in the form of tablets, 25 grams 1 gram or, if the drug is in the Amphetamines form of tablets, 25 grams
