### EXPORT CONTROL ACT (CHAPTER 299)

## EXPORT CONTROL (PROHIBITION OF SCRAP METAL AND COPPER) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2011

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Export Control Regulations Act, makes the following Regulations –

#### 1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Export Control (Prohibition of Scrap and Metal and Copper) (No. 2) Regulations, 2011.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2011.

### 2. Temporary prohibition of export of scrap metal.

No person shall for a period of fourteen days from the coming into force of these regulations export any scrap metal from The Bahamas to any place outside The Bahamas.

#### 3. Prohibition of export copper.

No person shall export any copper from The Bahamas to any place outside The Bahamas.
