(FOURTH SCHEDULE)

[Commencement 1st October, 1956]

Each of the following persons is hereby appointed an officer for the purposes of ensuring the enforcement of the Regulations —

- (a) the Deputy Controller of Exchange;
- (b) any officer of the Exchange Control who is specially authorised;
- (c) any police officer of and above the rank of assistant superintendent;
- (d) any customs officer;
- (e) any immigration officer.
