**FISHERIES RESOURCES (JURISDICTION AND
CONSERVATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Act, makes the following Regulations –

1. Citation.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 2012, and shall expire on the 28th day of February, 2013.

2. Amendment of Regulation 35 of Sub. Leg., Vol. IV, Ch. 244 – 11.

Regulation 35 of the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Regulations is amended –

- (a) by the renumbering of the paragraph as paragraph (1); and
- (b) by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (1), of the following new paragraphs (2) and (3) –

- “(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), no person shall take, land, possess, sell or offer for sale any fish commonly known as “the Nassau Grouper” during the period 1st December, 2012 to the 28th February, 2013, except where such taking or landing is carried out, with the written approval of the Director of Fisheries for scientific research purposes.
- (3) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall, during the period 1st December, 2012 to the 28th February, 2013, land any fish commonly known as “grouper” unless its head, tail and skin is intact.”.
