## PART I PRELIMINARY

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming Title. Regulations.
- **2.** In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby assigned to them respectively, that is to say —

Interpretation.

"Act" means the Lotteries and Gaming Act;

- "The Board" means the Gaming Board for the Bahama Islands established under the Act;
- "credit slip" means a form used to record an amount of money or chips removed from a gaming table and placed in a cashier's cage;
- "drop box" means a security container attached to a gaming table during play, which may contain money, chips, credit slips or fill slips, and to which access is restricted by the use of locks or locking devices;
- "fill slips" means a form used to record an amount of money or chips furnished to a gaming table from the cashier's cage;
- "licensed premises" means any premises in respect of which a licence under Part IV of the Act is for the time being in force.
