**INTER-INSULAR MAIL SHIPPING (RATES FOR THE CARRIAGE OF FREIGHT) RULES**

(SECTION 7)

*[Commencement 1st August, 1975]*

1. These Rules may be cited as the Inter-Insular Mail Shipping (Rates for the Carriage of Freight) Rules. Citation.

2. In these Rules, “the Act” means the Inter-Insular Mail Shipping Act. Interpretation.

3. (1) The master of any vessel employed in the operation of a shipping service under the Act may charge rates not exceeding the maximum rates set out in the Schedule opposite any goods, for the carriage of such goods on any vessel. Rates for the carriage of freight.  
Schedule.

(2) The master of any vessel who charges rates for the carriage of any goods thereon, exceeding the maximum rates specified in respect of such goods in the Schedule shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding sixty dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
