**INTERNATIONAL OBLIGATIONS
(ECONOMIC AND ANCILLIARY MEASURES)
(DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF KOREA)
ORDER**

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Democratic People’s Republic of Korea) Order, 2008.

Prohibition.

2. No person in The Bahamas and no Bahamian outside The Bahamas shall, directly or indirectly –

(a) supply, sell or transfer to the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea, by way of a Bahamian registered vessel or aircraft –

(i) battle tanks, armoured combat vehicles, large calibre artillery systems, combat aircraft, attack helicopters, warships, missiles or missile systems as defined for the purpose of the United Nations Register on Conventional Arms, or related material including spare parts, or items as determined by the Security Council or the Committee established pursuant to paragraph 12 of Security Council Resolution 17118 (2006) (“the Committee”);

(ii) items, materials, equipment, goods and technology in documents S/2006/814, S/2006/815, S/2006/853 and S/2006/853/CORR. 1 as set out in the Schedule; and

(iii) luxury goods;

(b) procure from the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea, the items in subparagraph (a) (i) and (ii); and

(c) provide to the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea any technical training, advice, services, or assistance related to the provision, manufacture, maintenance or use of the items in subparagraph (a) (i) and (ii).

(The Schedule originally Gazetted and mentioned in paragraph 2(a)(ii) is omitted in this revised edition.)
